- » Classes fill up quickly. You may pre-register online, by mail or in person at the F&CS Central Office or the Tulsa County Courthouse.
- » You may pre-register until three business days before a seminar. Registration may close earlier if a seminar is full.
- » Parties who wish to attend a seminar after the registration deadline may register at the door, space permitting.

WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW

- » Do not bring children to the program.
- » Plan to attend the seminar you have scheduled.
- » If you fail to attend, a \$20 rescheduling fee will be charged.
- » Credit is not given to late arrivals. You will be asked to reschedule. No exceptions.
- » Interpreter services for hearing-impaired are available by prior arrangement.
- » Bilingual interpreters are provided by the participant and only permitted at Tulsa location. Interpreter must be an adult 18 or over.
- » Participants receive a Certificate of Completion at the end of the seminar that should be filed at the courthouse.
- » The court is notified of your attendance only if you have provided your court case number and the name of the county in which your motion was filed.
- » You may request that another person not attend the same seminar as you.
- » Parties with protective orders may not attend together.
- » No refunds. No exceptions.
- » A workbook is available at the seminar for \$5.
- » This seminar is required for parties involved in any lawsuit involving custody, paternity, visitation or support of a minor child in these nine counties: Tulsa, Rogers, Wagoner, Mayes, Pawnee, Washington, Osage, Craig and Nowata.
