SUBSTANCE ABUSE & ADDICTION SERVICES

TREATMENT WORKS. RECOVERY IS POSSIBLE.
Start on the path to recovery. In several outpatient settings, we can give you the resources, supports and treatment options necessary to learn about addiction while developing sober living skills, coping tools and relapse prevention skills.

For some, addictions can result in involvement with law enforcement and the criminal justice system. Our staff works closely as a team with participants, families, other community treatment providers, court services and the Department of Corrections in order to provide the most appropriate diversion services for each individual. Eligible participants are referred to specific programs by designated parties within the criminal justice system.



OUTPATIENT SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT

We provide best-practice and gender sensitive treatment models. Treatment services include: assessment, group counseling, individual counseling, education, family services, case management, crisis intervention, court-related services, relapse prevention planning and appropriate aftercare services.

CO-OCCURRING TREATMENT

Our professional staff members are trained to provide simultaneous treatment for both mental illness and addiction issues through outpatient counseling, education and relapse prevention.

GAMBLING

We can help if you or a loved one is struggling with gambling problems. Our staff members have specialized certifications and training in gambling addiction.

MENTAL HEALTH COURT, DRUG COURT, & FEMALE DIVERSION SERVICES

We have significant experience in providing recovery-oriented services to individuals with mental illness, substance abuse and co-occurring disorders who are involved in court diversion and re-entry services. As an approved specialty court provider and Department of Corrections service provider, we help you meet court standards and treatment goals for recovery.

OFFENDER SCREENING

We help inmates who are at risk of reoffending due to mental health and substance abuse problems divert from incarceration to community-based treatment and services.





WOMEN IN RECOVERY (WIR)

This day treatment diversion program helps eligible, non-violent females facing incarceration for substance abuse offenses achieve recovery, self-sufficiency and reunification with their children.

RE-ENTRY

We are here to help persons with mental health and addiction disorders transition well into community life upon release from correctional institutions. This comprehensive program will provide you with mental health care and life skills, as well as connections to community resources, to help you successfully adjust to living independently in your community.

MENTAL HEALTH & PSYCHIATRY SERVICES

Recovery is possible for those with serious mental illness through psychiatry, pharmacy, case management, counseling, assertive community treatment, homeless outreach programs, wellness and other specialty services.

COPES—COMMUNITY OUTREACH PSYCHIATRIC EMERGENCY SERVICES

Our crisis intervention team provides 24-hour rapid telephone response and stabilization and mobile services for adults experiencing an emotional, behavioral or psychiatric emergency in Tulsa County. **Call 918.744.4800.**
